- Conversations following dinner: "Watching, Listening, Responding." Week 1 (12/4): Watching for God's Promises. Scripture: Isaiah 40:1–5, Luke 1:26–38 (the angel's message to Mary). Theme: Noticing what stirs in our hearts when God invites us to something new.

Week 2 (12/11): Listening for God in Our Midst. Scripture: Luke 2:8–20 (the shepherds hearing the good news). Theme: Recognizing God's presence in unexpected places.

Week 3 (12/18): Responding with Joy and Courage. Scripture: Matthew 2:1–12 (the Magi follow the star). Theme: Discerning how to act on what we've heard.
