Over this past year \$1.1 million of gifts from the Christmas Joy Offering were used to provide critical financial support and grants to current and retired Presbyterian church workers in their times of need. They were provided income supplements; housing and long-term care supplements; and emergency assistance grants.

More than \$800,000 of gifts are used to provide education and leadership development skills at Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color. Many students attending these schools and colleges are the first in their families to enroll in higher education.
