

We will meet at the church parking lot to leave at 8:30, or meet Marie Imai 8:45 at Lodato Trail start in Scotts Valley at North end of Green Hills Road at back of parking lot sign labeled Lodato Trail. You can choose the shorter 1.3 mile Redwood Forest Lodato Trail Loop with modest climb and then gather about 10 AM at The Coffee Cat Cafe, 255 Mt Herman Road, in the long strip mall. The longer hike, about 3.5 miles, also starts at 8:45 up Lodato Trail, then over hill to Scott Riddle's "Glitter Realm" Fairyland and on to Blair Ranch's life sized wood carvings of famous people (Obama, Trump, the Beatles...), full sized cars, animals, etc. This group will likely finish about 11:00 and could go to Coffee Cat if desired.
