Call to Confession

One: For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures. Knowing that Christ was willing to give up even his life for us, let us confess our sins and be open to the new

life he offers all who trust in him.

Prayer of Confession

All: Lord of Life, we often believe more in death than in life. We feel frustrated concerning the future and without hope as we look to the far horizons of our lives. Forgive us and fill us with the faith, hope, and love of our risen Savior.

Assurance of Forgiveness
